

Life on the Balcony

DIY Vertical Herb Garden with a Shoe Organizer

Don't have enough space in your place to grow some herbs? Turn a shoe organizer into a vertical garden and as long as you have even a balcony railing with sun exposure, you'll have more than enough room.

You're living in an apartment and dreaming of a garden's worth of fresh herbs for use in your kitchen, this simple hack will turn your vertical space into an herb growing high rise.

The design is simple. Hang a canvas shoe organizer, fill with potting soil, and plant your favorite herbs in the pouches. With some strong sun and adequate water you'll have a thriving spread of herbs to flavor your favorite dishes.

Step 1 - Materials Needed

- Hanging pocket shoe organizer /store.
- Pole and attachments (curtain pole or pipe fittings, screws).
- Strong metal saucepan or utensil hanging hooks
- Compost of a good quality moisture holding type.
- Selection of plants or seeds... e.g. mixed leaf salad, herbs, sorrel, peas, mini tomatoes.
- Piece of wood 2"x2" as long as the width of the pocket store to keep the base of pockets away from the wall.
- Trough planter to catch drips.

Step 2 - Attach pole to shed or wall

Step 3 - Attach hanging shoe organizer

Step 4 - Test drainage

Step 5 - Fill each pocket with compost, add good moisture retaining compost, and fill to 1" below the rim so that water does not pour out over the rim.

Step 6 - Add plants or seeds

Step 7 - "Drip Aid" Use a piece of wood to make sure the excess water drips into the trough below.

Creamy Potato Salad

YIELDS: 8 servings

TOTAL TIME: 25 minutes

2 ½ lb. red new potatoes, cut into 1/2in pieces

Kosher salt

Freshly ground black pepper

¾ c. low fat sour cream

1/4c. mayonnaise

3 tbsp. fresh lemon juice

2 tbsp. Dijon mustard

2 stalks celery, very thinly sliced

1 small bulb fennel, quartered, cored & sliced

1/4c. fresh flat-leaf parsley, chopped

2 tbsp. fresh tarragon, chopped

2 hardboiled eggs, cut in wedges

DIRECTIONS

1. Place potatoes in a large pot; cover with cold salted water. Cover pot and bring to a boil; reduce heat and simmer until the potatoes are just tender, 10 to 12 minutes; drain.
2. Meanwhile, whisk together sour cream, mayonnaise, lemon juice, and mustard in a bowl. Season with salt and pepper. Add warm potatoes and toss to coat; cool to room temperature. Add celery, fennel, parsley and tarragon. Toss to coat. Top with egg wedges just before serving.
